Furniture Distribution to Bhaneswari High School By NTPC Kaniha



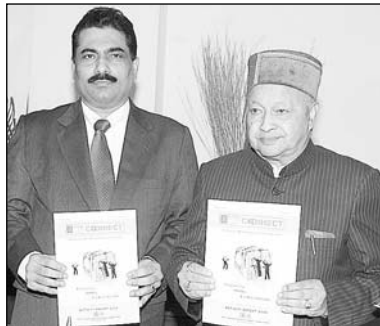
